On Thursday January 7, 2016 Princess Jaya Laxmi Shah, Rotary International District Governor-elect for Nepal and Bhutan, and her daughter Priti Shaw, Area Governor of Nepal were visiting Surrey at the invitation of Anup Singh Jubbal, President, Canadian Eyesight Global. They addressed a joint dinner meeting hosted by three Rotary Clubs – Rotary Club of Surrey-Guildford, Rotary Club of Surrey, and Rotary Club of Surrey-Newton – at Surrey's Grand Taj Banquet Hall on Thursday. Both ladies have extensive Rotary history with the Princess becoming the first female District Governor in Nepal.

They shared their Rotary experiences along with a presentation on the devastation caused by the April 2015 earthquake. The District 3292 has started for the redevelopment of many villages destroyed by the earthquake and have been providing temporary shelters, toilets and water supply.
