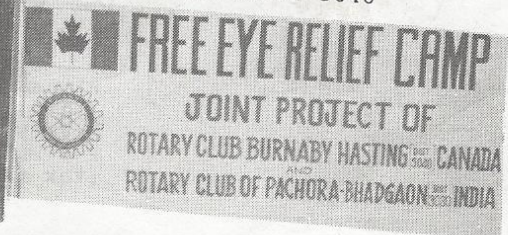
What a remarkable opportunity Project Eyesight-India offers these poor people! What a major change can be made in so many lives and so many families--Perhaps even some relatives and family in India.

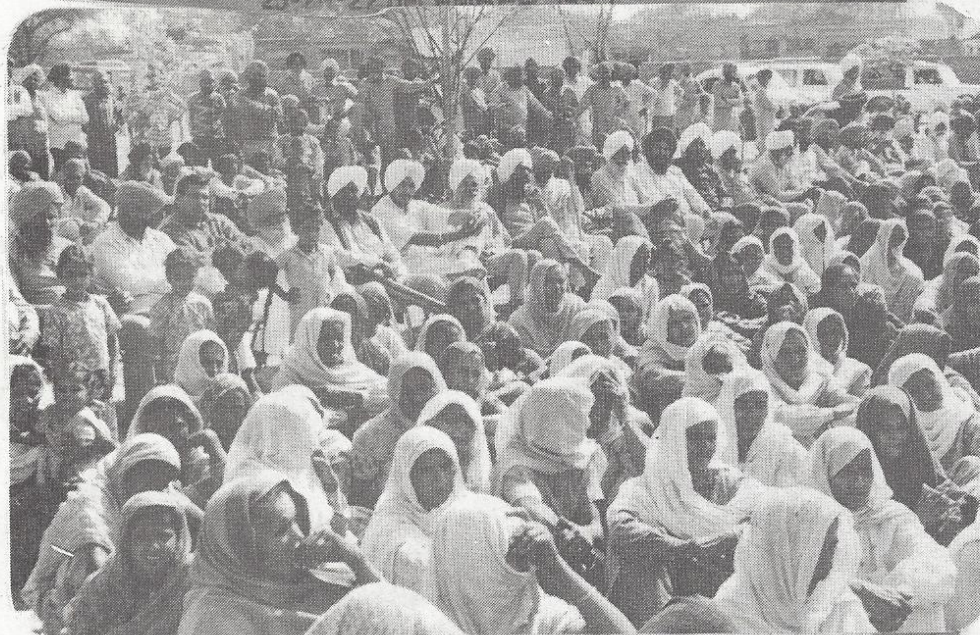

Cataract Surgery -
The Gift of Sight

I have had the pleasure of working as an Ophthalmologist for eight years in Canada and during that time have been able to help many people regain sight by cataract surgery. We live in a very wealthy and blessed Country where no one needs to remain blind or disabled because they have cataracts. It costs the Government about \$2,000.00 Canadian for a patient to have their cataract removed in Canada, this includes the cost of surgery, hospitalization and the Doctor's visits before and after the operation. During this eight years I have had numerous opportunities as well to serve overseas for brief episodes of time, two to four weeks, in third World Countries. In these Countries there are over 5 million people blind simply because they cannot afford to have their cataracts removed. These people become blind at a much younger age than we do here in Canada, in which the average age for cataracts is 74. In the Third World the average age is 40. They then face a life of great poverty and hardship for want of a simple operation to restore their sight. It has been my great joy to travel once or twice a year overseas and to help a few people regain their sight.

Rotary International Dist. 5040 B.C. Canada has undertaken with cataract Surgeons in India, to restore sight to 10,000 poor people. For a small donation of \$20.00, you can restore the sight to one poor blind person in India. Please think about these poor people and take this opportunity to help them.
